950.01 Legislative intent. In recognition of the civic and moral duty of victims and witnesses of crime to fully and voluntarily cooperate with law enforcement and prosecutorial agencies, and in further recognition of the continuing importance of such citizen cooperation to state and local law enforcement efforts and the general effectiveness and well—being of the criminal justice system of this state, the legislature declares its intent, in this chap-

- 5. If a person specified in subd. 1. has been adjudicated incompetent in this state, the guardian of the person appointed for him or her.
- (b) "Victim" does not include the person charged with or alleged to have committed the crime.
- (4m) "Victim and witness office" means an organization or program that provides services for which the county receives reimbursement under this chapter.
- (5) "Witness" means any person who has been or is expected


